THE TRIBAL FRONTIERS OF NORTH EAST INDIA

DAY 01: ARRIVAL KOLKATA

Arrive at Kolkata airport. Meet and greet with Warm Welcome! Garlanding with fresh marigold flowers and transfer to hotel for check in. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 02: KOLKATA – DIMAPUR (FLIGHT) & DIMPAUR – KOHIMA (70 KMS)

Morning after breakfast transfer to airport for the flight to Dimapur. Meet upon arrival in Guwahati airport and drive to Kohima – the capital of Nagaland and the home of the Angami Naga. On arrival check into hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 03: KOHIMA – DAY TRIP TO KHONOMA (20 KMS)

After breakfast we shall go for an excursion to Khonoma – the green village. Khonoma is an Angami-tribe warrior village that is known for its battles with the English and for its leading role in the Naga freedom struggle. In recent years Khonoma has become famous for its community-based conservation projects

DAY 04: KOHIMA - DAY TRIP TO JAKAHMA (20 KMS)

This morning we shall visit the Jakhama Village to witness the multifaceted Naga way of life. Walk through in the village takes you through paddy fields and the riverbanks where you can watch the Angamis fish and farm in their traditional ways, as they have done for hundreds of generations. As we weave through the village, we stop at local pigsties, fisheries and even a snail farm. Also see walls of houses riddled with bullet marks from World War II. Later visit the World War Cemetery – constructed in memory of the officers and men who made supreme sacrifices during World War II. Also visit the Kohima State Museum - a platform that exhibits the vibrant culture of Nagaland through a collection of fascinating arts and artifacts. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 05: KOHIMA – MOKOKCHUNG (150 KMS)

This morning we shall drive to Mokokchung. Enroute we shall visit some tribal villages. Later check in hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 06: MOKOKCHUNG

This morning we shall visit Longkhum – to witness the beauty which the magnificent Rhododendrons atop the hillocks. A single visit to this place is not enough. Later visit Ungma village - second largest village in Nagaland and the oldest and largest of the Ao tribe reside here. Believed to be the birthplace of the Ao tribe, the natives of this village have taken extra precautions to preserve the Ao culture and tradition. Return to hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 07: MOKOKCHUNG – MON (200 KMS)

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive towards Mon – the home of the Konyak Tribe. Enroute visit village inhabited by the Ao tribe of Mokokchung. On arrival check in to hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 08: MON

After breakfast, check out from hotel and drive to Longwah village. Longwah village in Mon district is one of the best places to see the unique diversity of Naga people. Located on the border of India and Myanmar. Return to hotel and overnight stay.

DAY 09: MON – DIBRUGARH (140 KMS)

After breakfast check out from hotel and transfer to Dibrugarh – known as the tea capital of Assam. On arrival check into hotel for overnight stay.

DAY 10: DIBRUGARH – LAKHIMPUR (140 KMS)

After a leisure breakfast, check out from hotel and drive to Lakhimpur – a little town located in the Northern bank of Brahmaputra River. On arrival to Lakhimpur check into hotel for overnight stay.

DAY 11: LAKHIMPUR – ZIRO (125 KMS)

After a leisure breakfast, check out from hotel and drive to Lakhimpur – a little town located in the Northern bank of Brahmaputra River. On arrival to Lakhimpur check into hotel for overnight stay.

DAY 12: ZIRO

To know more about the inhabitants we shall spend the day visiting Apatani villages as Hong, Dutta & Hari. In these villages, we shall see the houses of Apatani adjoining each other also interact with the locals and especially with the tattooed elder who still leave a very much traditional life. Later visit the Apatani farms. We shall also visit the local market. Later visit to the local market can be informative about knowing more about Apatani culture, customs, eating habits, attires and ornaments. Overnight at Ziro.

DAY 14: ZIRO – TEZPUR (270 KMS)

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive towards Tezpur. On arrival check into hotel for overnight stay.

DAY 15: TEZPUR – KOLKATA (FLIGHT)

Morning after breakfast transfer to airport to connect the flight for Kolkata. upon arrival transfer to hotel for check in at hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

DAY 16: DEPART FROM – KOLKATA

In time transfer to airport to board the flight for onward destination.
